Kratki životopis

Michele Bacciocchi was born in San Marino, October 3rd, 1990. He obtained the Bachelor and Master degrees in Civil Engineering at the University of Bologna in 2012 and 2014, both with grade 110/110 cum laude. PhD in Civil, Chemical, Environmental, and Materials Engineering was accomplished at the University of Bologna in 2018.

From November 2017 to November 2018 he was Research Fellow at the University of Bologna. From October 2018, he held his task of Adjunct Professor at the University of Bologna and at the University of San Marino.

Currently, he is Adjunct Professor and teacher of “Advanced Structural Mechanics” and “Computational Mechanics” at University of San Marino (Civil Engineering), and teacher of “Laboratory of Offshore Operations” at the University of Bologna.

His present research is focused on the numerical analysis of laminated composite plates made of innovative materials. The development of finite element codes to deal with the static and dynamic response of these structures is also his interest.

He is author of more than 45 international peer reviewed journal papers, 6 books (in Italian and English) and more than 30 abstracts in national and international conferences. He was member of the organizing committee of 6 International Conferences on composite structures and materials.
